






Hardest Job Made Harder

- Adding video can add context...unless done using the barbaric "binge" model
- Imagine 20 vehicles capturing all driving (say, 4 hours a day) for a week
- QUANTITY not Quality







Today's Hardest Job in the World Made Easier: Task-Centric

- Pick 10 key areas to investigate (tasks)
- Have your 20 drivers only capture things related to the 10 areas
- Design for 1–2 minutes per task
- QUALITY not Quality







Today's Hardest Job in the World Made Easier: Task-Centric




