GENIVI Vehicle Service Specification (VSS)

- A candidate ***common model for vehicle data***
- Extended by version 2.0 and ***freely available on github***
- ***Being deployed*** in production vehicles now
- Poised for expansion ***to include services & interfaces***
- ***A firm foundation for a Common Vehicle Interface Initiative (CVII)***

W3C Vehicle Interface Service Specification (VISS)

- ***Associated protocols and interfacing technologies to make use of the data/service model***
- Released as a ***W3C candidate recommendation***
- ***Being extended in version 2.0***
- Poised for expansion ***to include function calls (RPC-like)***
- ***A firm foundation for a Common Vehicle Interface Initiative (CVII)***

And now an even bigger vision ... CVII

- In-vehicle & In-cloud
- Data and functions/services
- Aligning with and / or leveraging other standards like Extended Vehicle, SENSORIS, AUTOSAR, eSync Alliance, JasPar, etc.
- Considering other ecosystems like IoT, V2X, smart mobility, smart cities, etc.
- Potentially unlocking significant cost savings for future programs as well as new business opportunities for OEMs, suppliers and third-parties
