Cookie Policy

A cookie is a small data file that certain Web sites write to your hard drive when you visit them. A cookie file can contain information such as a user ID that the site uses to track the pages you've visited, but the only personal information a cookie can contain is information you supply yourself. A cookie can't read data off your hard disk or read cookie files created by other sites.

The GENIVI Alliance may use cookies to identify what pages are being used and which ones aren't. This helps us analyze the Web page traffic and improve our site. The GENIVI Alliance may allow other companies that are present on some of our pages to set and access their cookies on your computer. Other companies' use of their cookies is subject to their own privacy policies, not this one. Other companies do not have access to cookies of the GENIVI Alliance.
